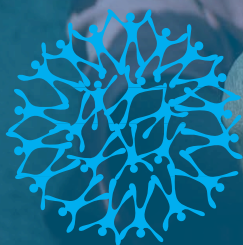

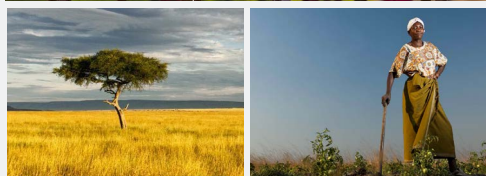

**The 6<sup>th</sup> Responsible Business Forum on Sustainable Development, co-organised by Global Initiatives and Regency Foundation Networx, will be held in Johannesburg, South Africa, in 31 August - 1 September 2017. The forum will help companies better understand the UN Sustainable Development Goals and the opportunities to collaborate with other stakeholders and support governments to achieve them.**

In an innovative and highly interactive format, delegates will be connected with decision makers from business, government, investors and the development community, to forge new partnerships and scale collaborations around the global goals.

A series of 17 facilitated workshops will provide a deeper look into each of the 17 SDGs, provide solutions for accelerating action and tools for measuring performance and impact.

Expert facilitators will introduce the goals with companies presenting case studies showing lessons from implementation. This will be followed by audience discussions around innovation and collaboration with other stakeholders.

A global media campaign will amplify the RBF 2017 messages. Digital, print and social media will call for consumers to play a role and urge big brands and governments to end poverty, protect and restore our planet, and ensure equality and prosperity for all.

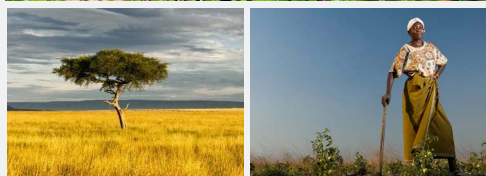
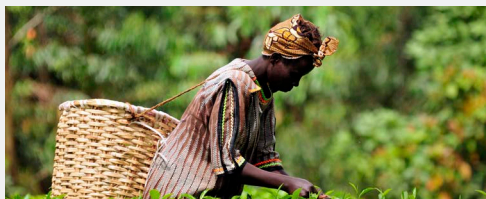
